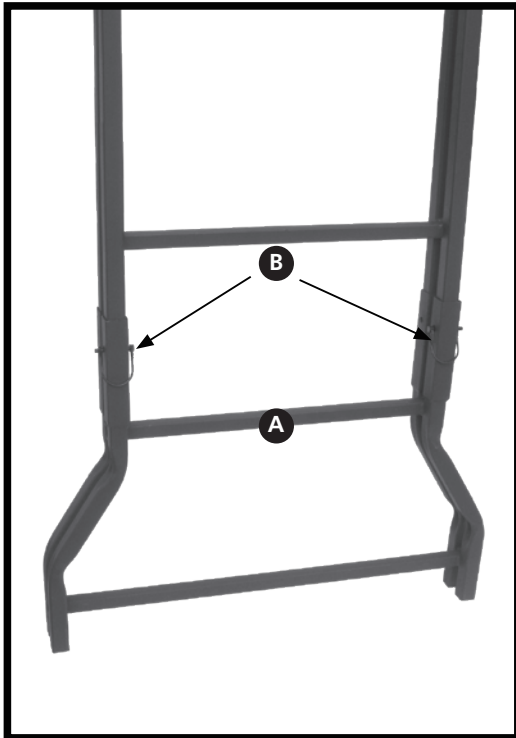

WARNING

- When hunting from a treestand, falls can occur at any time which can cause injury or death. Use a fall arrest system at all times prior to leaving the ground. Never be detached from the tree at anytime.
- Please do not return this product to the retailer. Call BIG DOG TREESTANDS toll free (1-866-387-2002) for quick replacement of any damaged or missing parts.
- This product ONLY fits Big Dog Treestand ladder stands Model #'s: BDL-490/1050/2050.



Please inspect the shipping carton for evidence of damage or that it may have been opened before you received it. Then inspect your product carefully. Compare it to the image on the product label and the picture illustration in your instructions. You must check and tighten all bolts before each use. If for any reason you are not satisfied with the product, do not use it until the problem is solved or corrected.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Raising/lowering requires (3) or more people. ALWAYS practice at ground level with FAS and treestand until comfortable with product use. Inspect FAS/Treestand/Straps before leaving the ground or getting onto the platform. Read/Understand ALL instructions/warnings prior to each use. If adding on existing model in field, you will need to remove product from tree to add extension. Insure ladder ends, treestand, ratchet/button straps, stabilizing straps/ropes are free of damage or debris.

Insert Base Stabilizer into the end on the ladder section. Secure together using (2) Quick Pins. Note: Insure ladder end is free of damage/wear or debris of the ladder section. Do not use if any exist.

WARNING

- Proper threading of straps is critical. Insure all straps are properly threaded and free of damage/wear prior to each use.
- Replace ALL straps (ratchet/button/stabilizing) annually and ALL Hardware (bolts/nuts/cables) every (2) years. Use only Big Dog Treestands certified replacement parts/components, all others are viewed as a modification to the product. Frequently lubricate all hardware/parts or as needed.
- Insure ALL contact points of the treestand/FAS are in contact/secured with the tree before climbing onto the platform.
- Inspect/Insure ground under bottom ladder section is firm/level and all sections are connected/pinned together and the adjustable support bar is secured properly prior to each use and prior to leaving the ground. Do not use if sections are separated.
- Always test/practice at ground level w/treestand and FAS until comfortable with use of products.
- DO NOT REMOVE/INSTALL/USE ANYTHING WITHOUT REVIEWING/UNDERSTANDING ALL THE TREESTANDS INSTRUCTIONS/SAFETY WARNINGS.
- Use of this product requires removing this product from against the tree. Review your models instructions for proper removal/set-up/use of this product before adding anything to this treestand. Inspect straps/treestand for wear/damage before use/installation.
- Always Test/Practice at ground level with treestand/FAS until comfortable with use.
- Use of a FAS is required during use of any treestand/acc.'s at all times during use/prior to leaving the ground.
- Insure to stand on BOTTOM rung of the base stabilizer until it has sunk and ground rests on bottom side of the Stabilizer rung.
